	<p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any Solid color Oxford or other solid color long & short sleeve button front
	<p>POLO SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Polo style knit shirt Long & short sleeve Solid color only/No contrasting trim No logos or emblems except PHCA
	<p>TURTLENECKS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No mocks Solid color only
<p>SWEATERS / CARDIGANS / VESTS / PHCA SWEATSHIRT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any Solid color No contrasting trim Must be worn over in-code shirt or with turtleneck No HOODS No sweatshirts or fleece PHCA logo sweatshirts may be worn in place of sweaters 	
	<p>UNIFORM SLACKS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy blue, black, dark gray or khaki only Dress style-twill or corduroy fabric only Pleated or plain front No cargo pockets or rivets NO JOGGER STYLE PANTS Belted or non-belted Plain, solid colored belt must be worn if slacks have belt loops. (K / 1 Exempt) No drawstring waists
	<p>UNIFORM SHORTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Black, navy blue, dark gray or khaki only Knee-length shorts No cargo pockets or rivets Plain solid colored belt must be worn if shorts have belt loops (K / 1 exempt) No drawstring waists To the knee or no more than 2" above
<p>(Shorts may NOT be worn on Chapel days.)</p>	<p>Shorts may be worn: August, September and May.</p>

	<p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dress or tennis shoes Tennis shoes with non-marking soles must be worn for PE classes No open back shoes, sandals, or boots
	<p>SOCKS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any SOLID color
<p>CHAPEL DAYS - Boys will not be required to wear the formal dress code uniform. It will be optional. Boys may now wear their everyday school uniform on Chapel Day. No shorts on Chapel Day.</p>	
<p>JEANS DAY / JEANS DAY CERTIFICATE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A special JEANS DAY may be announced at the end of each quarter. Students may wear blue jeans. Throughout the year, Jeans Certificates may be given out as various rewards. Blue jeans may be worn in place of dress code pants/shorts. Dress code shirt must still be worn, tucked in, with a solid color belt. (K / 1 Exempt) No holey, frayed or ripped jeans allowed. In August, September and May only, blue jean shorts may be used with a Jeans Pass. Jean shorts must be hemmed (no cutoffs) and in good condition (no more than 2" above the knee). 	
<p>OTHER STIPULATIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> HAIRSTYLES should be conservative and modest. Any hair style that demonstrates an extreme is inappropriate. Hair must be cut so that it is above the collar in back, above the eyebrows in front, and no longer than the earlobes on the sides. LOGOWEAR...Shirts with PHCA emblem may be worn. (P.E. gym shirts are only to be worn at gym time) BELTS...plain, solid colored only (K/1 Exempt) NO TAILS or PONYTAILS and NO EARRINGS P.E. Uniforms are required for Grades 5, 6, 7, 8
