

Parma Heights Christian Academy Girls' Dress Code



BLOUSES

 Solid color long & short sleeve button front blouse with round or pointed collar and appropriate undergarments.



POLO SHIRTS

- Polo style knit shirt/dress
- · Long and short sleeve
- · Any solid color.
- No logos or emblems except PHCA



TURTLENECKS

- No mocks
- Any solid color

SWEATERS/ CARDIGANS/ VESTS/ PHCA SWEATSHIRT

- Any SOLID color
- No contrasting trim
- Must be worn over in-code blouse or with turtleneck
- No HOODS
- · No sweatshirts or fleece
- PHCA logo sweatshirts may be worn in place of sweaters



UNIFORM SKIRTS/SKORTS

- Navy blue, black, dark gray, khaki or plaid
- To the knee or no more than 2" above
- Belts must be worn if skirts have belt loops (K/1 exempt)




UNIFORM JUMPER

- Navy blue, black, dark gray, khaki or plaid
- To the knee or no more than 2" above



POLO DRESS

- Any **solid** color / No contrasting trim
- To the knee or no more than 2" above



Shorts may be worn: August, September and May only

Shorts may NOT be worn

UNIFORM SHORTS/CAPRIS

- Black, navy blue, dark gray or khaki
- No cargo pockets or rivets
- Plain solid colored belt must be worn if shorts have belt loops (K/1 exempt)
- To the knee or no more than 2" above



UNIFORM SLACKS

- · Navy blue, black, dark gray or khaki
- Dress style-twill or corduroy fabric only
- Pleated or plain front
- No cargo pockets or rivets
- · Belted or non-belted
- Plain, solid color belt must be worn if slacks have a belt loop (K/1 Exempt)



SOCKS/TIGHTS/LEGGINGS

- Any SOLID color socks or tights
- Leggings (SOLID colors of navy, black, gray or white only. Cotton ONLY. Socks must be worn. No capri leggings.



SHOES

- · Dress or tennis shoes
- Tennis shoes with non-marking soles must be worn for PE classes
- Heels no higher than 11/2"
 - No open back shoes, sandals, tall boots
- Dress Ankle Boots in dark, solid color ONLY

CHAPEL DAYS - Girls will no longer be required to wear the formal dress code uniform. It will be optional. Girls may now wear their everyday school uniform on Chapel Day. No shorts on Chapel Day.

JEANS DAY / JEANS DAY CERTIFICATE

- A special JEANS DAY may be announced at the end of each quarter. Students may wear blue jeans.
- Throughout the year, Jeans Certificates may be given out as various rewards. *Blue jeans* may be worn in place of dress code pants/shorts.
- Dress code shirt must still be worn, tucked in, with a solid color belt.
- No holey, frayed or ripped jeans allowed.
- In August, September and May only, blue jean shorts may be used with a Jeans Pass. Jean shorts must be hemmed (no cutoffs) and in good condition (no more than 2" above the knee).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- HAIRSTYLES should be feminine and modest, not worn over the eyes. No unnatural hair color (pink, blue, etc.) and no hairstyle that demonstrates an extreme.
- HEADBANDS with ears, pompoms and costume decorations are NOT ALLOWED.
- LOGOWEAR...Shirts with PHCA emblem may be worn (P.E. gym shirts are only to be worn at gym time)
- BELTS...plain, solid colored only (K/1 Exempt)
- EARRINGS ... no hoop or dangling
- SCARVES...no scarves may be worn during school day
- MAKE-UP, if worn with approval of parents, should be conservative and modestly applied. Administrator reserves the right to request modifications to make-up if extreme.
- Shorts under skirt or jumper at all times is REQUIRED.
- P.E. Uniforms required for grades 5, 6, 7, 8

VIOLATION OF DRESS CODE
