	<b>SHIRTS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 <b>Solid</b> color Oxford or other <b>solid</b> color long &amp; short sleeve button front shirt</li> </ul>		<b>SHOES</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dress or tennis shoes</li> <li>Tennis shoes with non-marking soles must be worn for PE classes</li> <li>No open back shoes, sandals, or boots</li> </ul>
	<b>POLO SHIRTS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Polo style knit shirt</li> <li>Long &amp; short sleeve</li> <li><b>Solid</b> color only/No contrasting trim</li> <li><b>No logos or emblems except PHCA</b></li> </ul>		<b>SOCKS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any <b>SOLID</b> color</li> </ul>
	<b>TURTLENECKS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No mocks</li> <li><b>Solid</b> color only</li> </ul>	<b>CHAPEL DAYS</b> - Boys will not be required to wear the formal dress code uniform. It will be optional. Boys may now wear their everyday school uniform on Chapel Day. No shorts on Chapel Day.	
<b>SWEATERS / CARDIGANS / VESTS / PHCA SWEATSHIRT</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any <b>Solid</b> color</li> <li>No contrasting trim</li> <li>Must be worn over in-code shirt or with turtleneck</li> <li>No <b>HOODS</b></li> <li>No sweatshirts or fleece</li> <li>PHCA logo sweatshirts may be worn in place of sweaters</li> </ul>		<b>JEANS DAY / JEANS DAY CERTIFICATE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A special JEANS DAY may be announced at the end of each quarter. Students may wear <b>blue jeans</b>.</li> <li>Throughout the year, Jeans Certificates may be given out as various rewards. <b>Blue jeans</b> may be worn in place of dress code pants/shorts.</li> <li><b>Dress code shirt must still be worn, tucked in, with a solid color belt. (K / 1 Exempt)</b></li> <li><b>No holey, frayed or ripped jeans allowed.</b></li> <li>In August, September and May only, <b>blue jean shorts</b> may be used with a Jeans Pass. Jean shorts must be hemmed (<b>no cutoffs</b>) and in good condition</li> </ul>	
	<b>UNIFORM SLACKS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Navy blue, black, dark gray or khaki only</li> <li>Dress style-twill or corduroy fabric only</li> <li>Pleated or plain front</li> <li>No cargo pockets or rivets</li> <li><b>NO JOGGER STYLE PANTS</b></li> <li>Belted or non-belted</li> <li>Plain, <b>solid</b> colored belt must be worn if slacks have belt loops. (K / 1 Exempt)</li> <li>No drawstring waists</li> </ul>	<b>OTHER STIPULATIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>HAIRSTYLES</b> should be conservative and modest. Any hair style that demonstrates an extreme is inappropriate. Hair must be cut so that it is above the collar in back, above the eyebrows in front, and no longer than the earlobes on the sides.</li> <li><b>LOGOWEAR</b>...Shirts with PHCA emblem may be worn. (P.E. shirts are not allowed)</li> <li><b>BELTS</b>...plain, <b>solid</b> colored <b>only (K/1 Exempt)</b></li> <li><b>NO TAILS</b> or <b>PONYTAILS</b> and <b>NO EARRINGS</b></li> <li><b>P.E. Uniforms are required for Grades 5 &amp; 6</b></li> </ul> <b>VIOLATION OF DRESS CODE</b> Student will be instructed to write the portion of the dress code in violation for the parent to sign and return.	
	<b>UNIFORM SHORTS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Black, navy blue, dark gray or khaki only</li> <li>Knee-length shorts</li> <li>No cargo pockets or rivets</li> <li>Plain <b>solid</b> colored belt must be worn if shorts have belt loops (K / 1 exempt)</li> <li>No drawstring waists</li> <li>To the knee or no more than 2" above</li> </ul>		
(Shorts may <b>NOT</b> be worn on Chapel days.)	Shorts may be worn: <b>August, September and May.</b>
